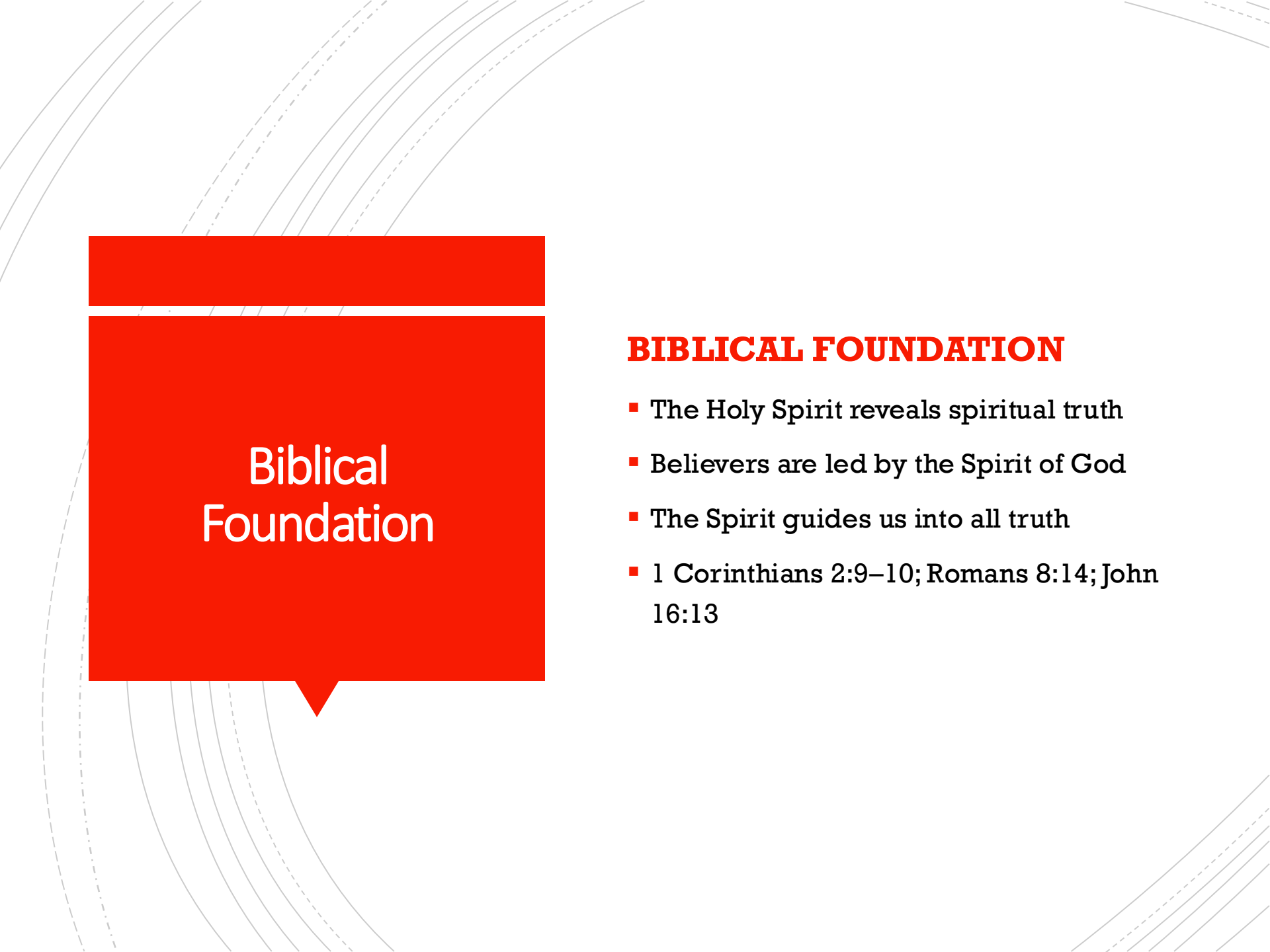

What Is Spiritual Sensitivity?

SENSITIVITY

- Ability to perceive and respond to the Holy Spirit
- Developed through relationship, not emotion
- God is always speaking — we must learn to listen
- John 10:27

Elijah

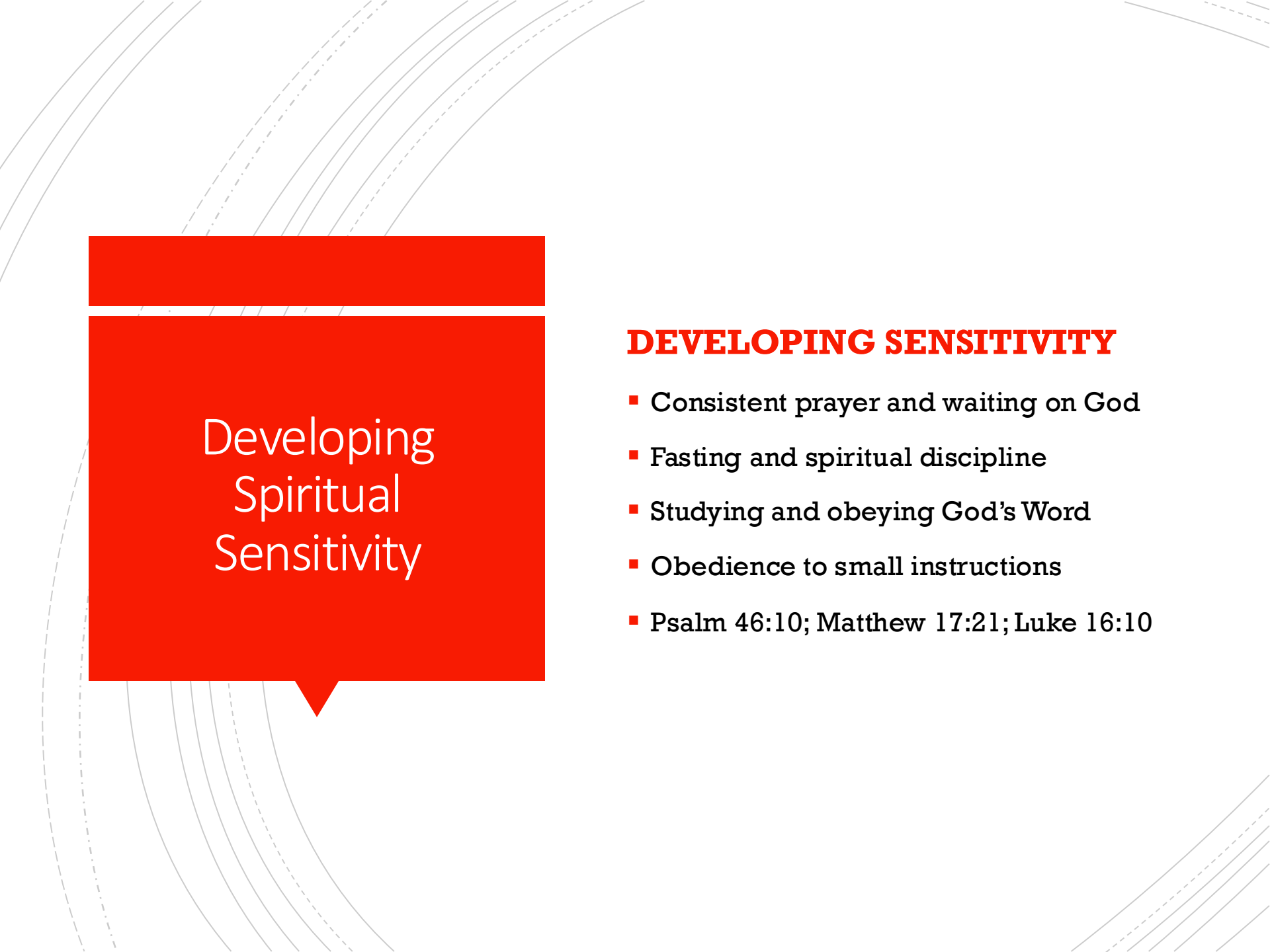
ELIJAH EXPERIENCE

DEVELOPING SENSITIVITY

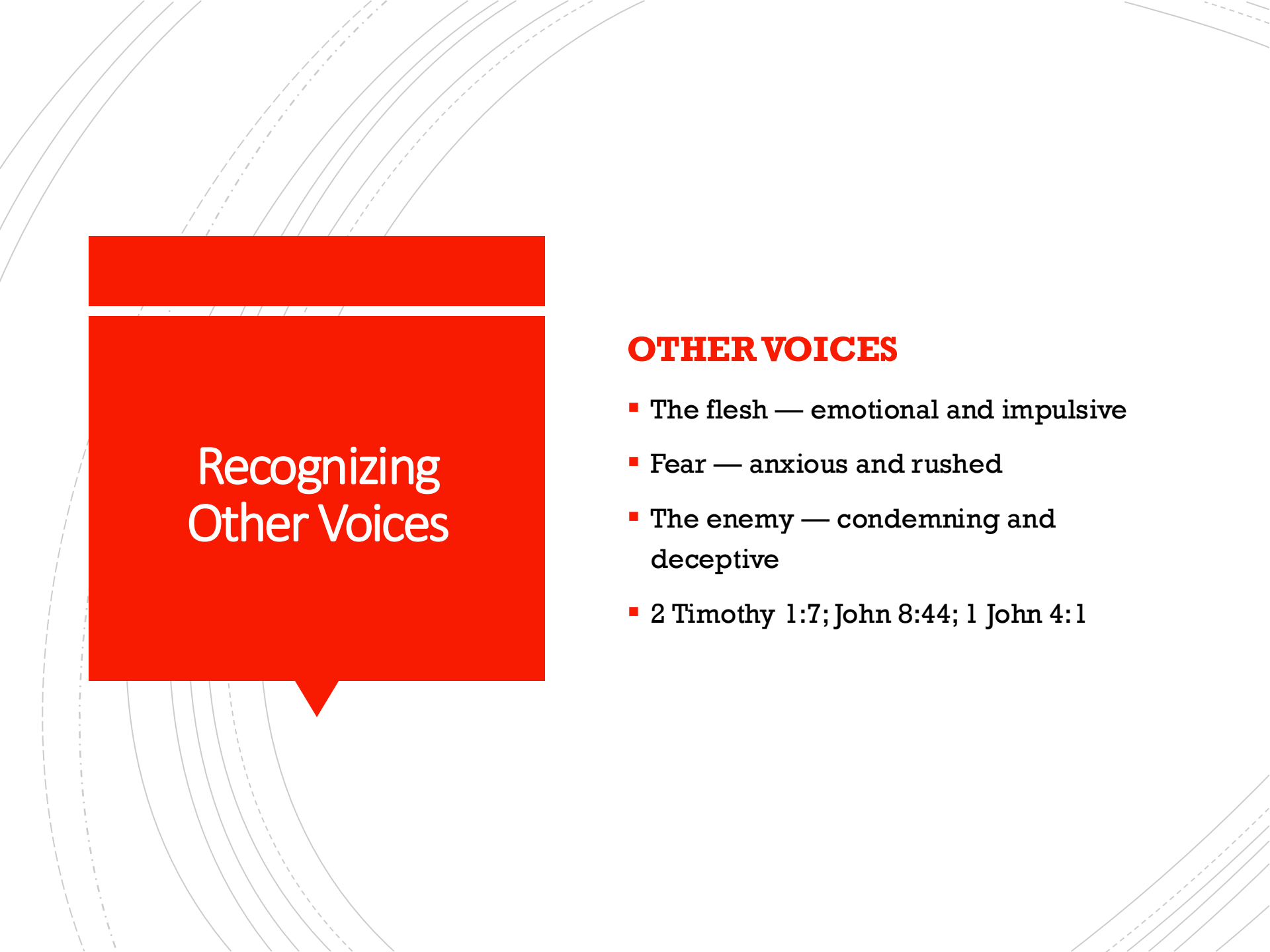
- Consistent prayer and waiting on God

- Obedience to small instructions
- Psalm 46:10; Matthew 17:21; Luke 16:10

GOD'S VOICE

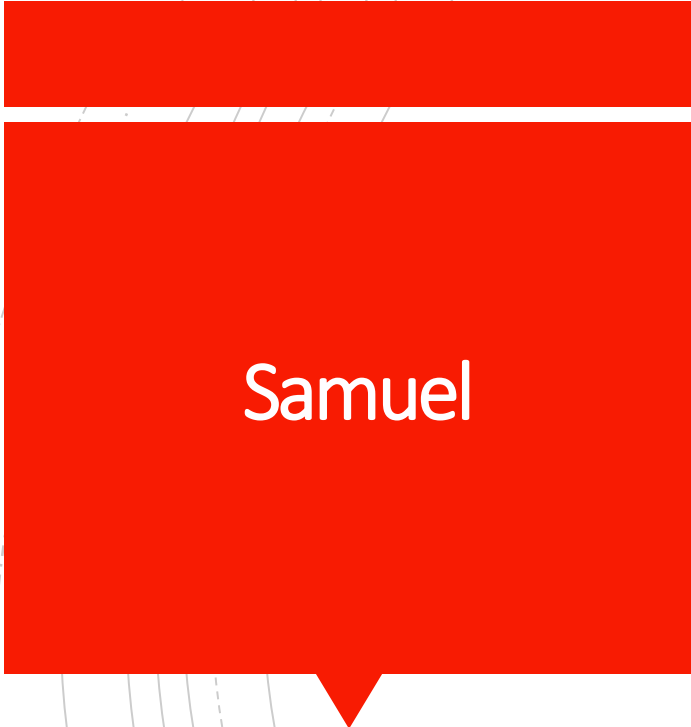
- God's voice aligns with Scripture
- Produces peace, not confusion
- Leads toward righteousness
- Colossians 3:15; James 3:17

OTHER VOICES

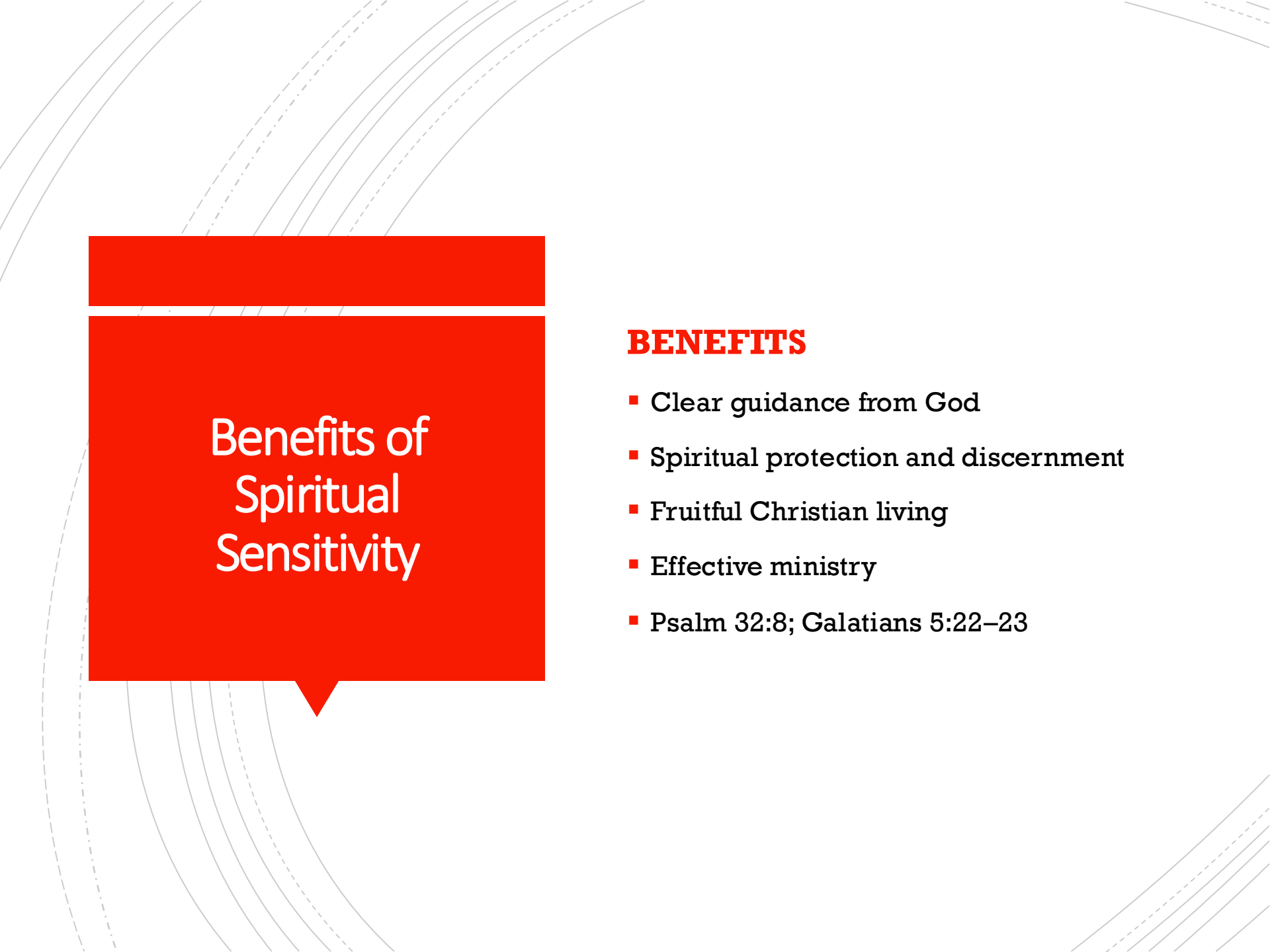
- The flesh — emotional and impulsive
- Fear — anxious and rushed
- The enemy — condemning and deceptive
- 2 Timothy 1:7; John 8:44; 1 John 4:1
